Our speaker in May, Tom Clemens, delivered to those assembled, an review of the lifelong work of Ezra Carman to document the Battle of Antietam. It was amazing to understand how many other works have used Carmen's work as their baseline data.

Tom's review of how history comes to be documented, whether correctly or incorrectly, was truly insightful.

Ed Longacre: J.E.B. Stuart's Lieutenants

Our speaker in May will be Edward G. Longacre. Ed will present a program on J.E.B. Stuart's Lieutenants. This promises to be an excellent complement to our program on Stuart in the Gettysburg Campaign earlier this year.

Ed Longacre has written more than twenty books and over one hundred journal and magazine articles on the Civil War. The Cavalry at Gettysburg won the Fletcher Pratt Award as the best book of Civil War nonfiction. Pickett, Leader of the Charge was a finalist for the Douglas Southall Freeman Award. Lee's Cavalrymen was a main selection of the History Book Club. He was a historical advisor to the 1993 motion picture Gettysburg.

Ed Longacre lives in Newport News, Virginia, where he is a civilian historian for the United States Air Force.

- **3 June 1861:** Battle of Philippi [West Virginia]. First land engagement of the Civil War between American and Confederate forces
- **8 June 1861:** Tennessee secedes from the Union
- **10 June 1861:** Battle of Big Bethel [Virginia]. Considered first full scale battle of the Civil War
- **30 June 1861:** The CSS Sumter, Raphael Semmes, ran the blockade at New Orleans beginning her career as the first Confederate States commerce raider.
- **14 July 1861:** A Federal blockade was set up at Wilmington by the USS Daylight.
