The Civil War Round Table of Atlanta was honored to have noted Civil War historian, James M. McPherson, as our guest in March as we gave him our "Richard B. Harwell Award" for his book, *Tried by War: Abraham Lincoln as Commander-In-Chief.*

Jeffry Wert on the Stonewall Brigade vs. the Iron Brigade

Jeffry Wert returns to our Round Table in April with a program centered on the Confederate "Stonewall Brigade" and the Union "Iron Brigade". In addition to his book on the subject, A Brotherhood of Valor: The Common Soldiers of the Stonewall Brigade, C.S.A., and the Iron Brigade, U.S.A, Jeffry is the author of several other books related to the War. They include: Cavalryman of the Lost Cause: A Biography of J.E.B. Stuart; The Sword of Lincoln: The Army of the Potomac; Gettysburg, Day Three; Custer; General James Longstreet: The Confederacy's Most Controversial Soldier; and Mosby's Rangers

His focus for our program will be on the ordinary men who became members of two of the most respected fighting units of their respective armies, the Stonewall Brigade and the Iron Brigade. These two brigades confronted each other on several bloody fields of battle: Sharpsburg (Antietam), Gettysburg, and Chancellorsville The men of these units also left a great paper trail.

Don't miss our April meeting and hear Mr. Wert relate the stories of the men of these elite unites of their respective armies as seen through their eyes.
